. Old business	<p>a. Lake Study Grants for 2015. Nick read all 3 reports finding a few glitches which he reported back to Dean Premo. Round Lake was noted for some invasives on the shore: phragmites and purple loosestrife; the later also had 20 plants on Rice Creek. These terrestrials were not on the map and discussion was for that to occur so that they could be found and dealt with. An extension has been granted for these grants</p> <p>b. Lake Study Grants for 2016. Lynx Lake had their floating workshop; the researchers dove for snails and a shoreline assessment was done. Dean reports that a floating workshop will be on Papoose Lake Aug. 14 at 9 AM. A virtual floating workshop will be at the Presque Isle Library on August 24 at 9 AM and is open to the public.</p> <p>c. Lake Study Grant for 2017- Twin Island and Little Presque isle are havng their shoreline studied; the rest of the study will be done in August. McCullough, Morton, and Dunn have just had the intercepts done. Oxbow and Stateline studies are underway.</p> <p>d. CBCW Early July push- the July 4th push was done at Natural Lakes; there was a boat wash at Trout Lake; there were fewer boats than over Memorial Day weekend. Free items were available at the Discovery Center for CBCW folks to give to boaters.</p> <p>e. Other – a thank you to the Barofskys was circulated. Their many years as PITLC workers in many capacities was noted, emphasis on the secretary and co-chair responsibilities. We wish them well as they take their expertise to the Wisconsin Lakes and Rivers organization. Pat also requested that we complete our membership in that organization and Nick said he'd take care of that and supply the library with the magazine that is included.</p>
New Business	<p>a. Association Networking – Barry MacLean made a request to ask if any PITLC members were interested in discussion about the town. The exact purpose wasn't clear but several said that Nick could forward their emails to Barry to learn more about this. Barry is the president of the Crab Lake Assoc.</p> <p>b. Cathy Logan Weber asked if any of us were aware of the Snapshot Day studies conducted by the DNR. Ruchs have participated in the past. She also said that the town website is in revision and that we should be able to directly send our minutes to it in the future. The website is pi.wi.us</p> <p>c. Discussion was held about the availability of Vilas County On-Line Mapping.</p> <p>d. Beth Keble, the chair for The Musky Classic is asking for help again for CBCW. Nick will talk to her about using folks on those lakes.</p> <p>e. Next meeting is August 14, 2018 at 7 PM in the community center.</p>
