

Presque Isle Volunteer Fire Department
Minutes: January 5, 2021

Treasurer's Report: There were no bills for approval. Checking = \$14,587.68. Savings = \$51,733.63 for a total balance of \$66,321.31. End of year finances - Sarah will get run report #s to Lorine and end of year balance and volunteer funds report. Doug will work on LOSA + budget report, etc.

Fire Dept. Old Business: We are still awaiting delivery of equipment (delayed); this was paid for in 2020 so it would fall on that budget. Masks are ordered and should be arriving mid-month.

Fire Dept. New Business:

The 2021 calendar will be posted and includes a structured fire approach, review re: mutual aid, etc. A cold water rescue being planned with PI as the accredited host - working out with AVW's Mike Bernard to open to other area members. This will be on Tuesday 2/23 (evening class) and Saturday 2/27 (day, in the field).

Main Street will be closed for a week sometime spring/summer 2021. Tentative plan is to house trucks at Town Garage. Ambulance may be able to drive to ponds by cafe - Doug is working on permissions.

There was a heater leak temporarily fixed by Corky - a permanent fix is being scheduled.

Officer 1/2 class online by Nicolet. Anyone that is an officer needs to take by end of January.

Donna will inform group how to sign up.

Corky is currently a probationary member and needs an updated status. A motion to move Corky to full member made by Sarah, second by Donna. All officers: aye.

EMS New Business:

There is an upcoming classes for EMR/EMS at Little Rice, 1/23-3/20 on Saturdays 9am-5pm.

CPR class is on Feb 2/16. Registering are: Al, Joe, Ken, Carl, Doug, and Mark. Donna will handle registration.
